

The Hemisphere catamaran, built by Pendennis, is 44.2m (145ft) long with a 16.6m (54.46ft) beam and 3.25m (10.7ft) draft. It has a maximum speed of 13 knots powered by two 490 HP Caterpillar engines, and can accommodate 12 guests in 5 cabins. Key specifications also include a gross tonnage of 499 GT, an aluminum hull and superstructure, and a sail area of 12,037 square feet.

The Hemisphere catamaran's key features include its impressive size, it was the world's largest sailing catamaran until 2024. a unique "seagull wings" design and extensive watersports and exploration equipment. It also boasts a spacious flybridge with a jacuzzi, a large tender garage that can house a 16.4m sports fishing tender, and a custom-built PADI certified dive center.
