

The Preference 19 is a 36.4m (119'5") expedition motor yacht built by Tansu with a steel hull and aluminum superstructure. Its specifications include a 7.4m beam, 2.2m draught, and a range of 3,000 nautical miles at a cruising speed of 12 knots. It is powered by two Caterpillar C32 engines (1,300 HP each), can reach a top speed of 16 knots, and accommodates up to 10 guests in five cabins.
